The Spartanburg Youth Theatre encourages boys and girls in the <u>3<sup>rd</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades</u> of all ethnicities and backgrounds to audition.

Anticipated cast size = 4-8

#### ALL ROLES ARE AVAILABLE. NO ROLES HAVE BEEN PRECAST.

#### **AVAILABLE ROLES:**

The show is written for 3-4 actors to narrate and puppeteer all of the characters in four different Eric Carle stories. Actors auditioning will be considered for all roles, and the lines and parts will be distributed equally among the cast. Actors will be seen onstage throughout the entire show and will interact with all other puppets and the audience. The cast will maneuver 75 puppets, so the director may choose to adjust the number of actors cast and may redistribute lines/tracks as needed. All actors must display acting and physical range to play multiple characters. They must also be able to move well and maneuver oversized puppets (some as large as six feet).

## **SHOW INFO:**

Eric Carle's timeless classics will come to life on the SYT stage, featuring a menagerie of over 75 magical puppets. Other Carle stories including Brown Bear, Brown Bear, 10 Little Rubber Ducks, and The Very Lonely Firefly accompany the show, ending with the star of the show - The Very Hungry Caterpillar! These beloved tales and their messages of community, self-expression, and the power of creativity are brought to life by a captivating cast of storytellers, sweeping original music, and stunning puppetry.

# **AUDITION DATES & TIME:**

Tuesday, January 14, 2025 <u>or</u> Wednesday, January 15, 2025, 5:30pm-7:30pm both nights. You should only audition one of the two nights offered. You may come any time between the 5:30-7:30pm range. Auditionees will be seen in the order their audition form is received. Once an actor has auditioned, they may leave. They do not need to stay for the entire 2-hour timeframe. If you cannot audition on the two offered dates, we MAY be able to accommodate a separate audition date, but we cannot guarantee it. Please <u>contact us</u> directly.

Save time and fill out your audition form ahead of time. An online audition form will be available on Friday, January 10, 2025 on the "Auditions" page of the website: <a href="http://www.spartanburgyouththeatre.com/auditions">www.spartanburgyouththeatre.com/auditions</a>. If you fill out your form ahead of time, head straight to the check-in table when you arrive and tell them you filled out your form online. It is not mandatory to fill out your form in advance. You may still fill out the form when you arrive.

## CALLBACKS:

A callback list will be posted **by 8:00pm** on *Thursday, January 16, 2025* via the auditions page on the SYT website (<u>www.spartanburgyouththeatre.com/auditions</u>). At callbacks, actors will read scenes from the script, do exercises with the director, and work with puppets.

Callbacks will be **Saturday, January 18, 2025 from 10am-2pm**. The date of callbacks is subject to change pending actor & creative team availability. If an actor is unable to attend callbacks, we MAY be able to accommodate a separate callback date, but we cannot guarantee it. If called back, <u>contact SYT</u> and they will see what they can do.

If an actor must arrive late or leave early, please understand that SYT will do their best to accommodate the conflict but cannot guarantee that they will be able to make sure the actor is seen before they have to leave early or after they've arrived late.

# **PREPARATION:**

- All auditionees should prepare the following for auditions
  - 1. Prepare one of the three monologues provided from the show. Monologues can be found by <u>clicking</u> <u>here</u>. Paper copies of the monologues can also be found at the Spartanburg Youth Theatre offices in The kiosk at the end of the hallway when you walk down the stairs to our area.
    - a. While normally SYT would ask actors to choose their own monologue, we strongly prefer that for this production actors only use one of the monologues provided.
    - b. Auditionees may choose any one of the 3 monologues provided.
    - c. Actors are highly encouraged to have the monologues fully memorized. Actors should show very strong storytelling skills with vocal intonation, bold physical movement, and strong facial expressions.
    - d. Copies of the monologue will also be available at the audition if you're unable to prepare ahead of time.
  - 2. Be prepared to pantomime as an animal that is seen in the stories (a bear, a caterpillar, a duck, etc). Actor may choose whichever animal they would like, but they should be able to demonstrate that they're able to portray non-human characteristics through their movement, since in the show the actors will be manipulating and providing movement for animal puppets.

# • Bring your schedule to fill-in all of your potential rehearsal conflicts on the audition form—<u>conflicts</u> <u>cannot be added after casting!</u>

## **ANTICIPATED REHEARSAL SCHEDULE:**

- Rehearsals will occur Feb 24-April 2, 2025-- but not every day. Rehearsals will mainly occur Monday- Friday (5:30-7:30pm).
- REQUIRED DATES ASIDE FROM REHEARSALS
  - o Load-in: Saturday, March 29, 2025, 12-4pm
  - If actors are unavailable for Load-in, they must make up the hours missed from these days. Makeup hours will be coordinated on a case-by-case basis.
- \*\*As of Monday, March 24, 2025, conflicts are <u>highly discouraged</u>. Conflicts during this time frame may prevent an actor from getting cast.\*\*
- The week of Mar 24-28, 2025, rehearsals will last from 5:30pm-*8:30pm*.
- A *preliminary* schedule of planned rehearsal days is listed on the next page. However, *rehearsals are subject to change!* Actor conflicts will be allowed within reason but must be listed on the audition form. Conflicts *cannot* be added after casting. *Conflicts may be a deciding factor in casting*.
