



Director's Note

I love this show. The Wizard of Oz is the first movie I remember as a kid. My mom would play with my hair as I watched in tense anticipation as Dorothy, Scarecrow, Tin Man, and The Cowardly Lion battled the Wicked Witch. The movie was on constant rotation for every sick day and during the holidays. Ever the performer, I would walk down the hallway with my baby blanket draped over my shoulders like the Cowardly Lion and sing "If I Were King of the Forest." I'm sure that is where my vibrato developed! In 2012, I played Dorothy in my high school's production! My whole family, including some all the way from Washington state, came out to see the show. What followed was my dad showing everyone he could a video he illegally took of me singing "Over the Rainbow." Then subsequently a bedroom redecoration to be *Wizard of Oz* themed at both my parents' houses. I received vintage sheet music from the show, music boxes, and a homemade Wizard of Oz blanket from my mom that I keep in my office. My sister even gave me an entire Oz themed gift basket to ask me to be her maid of honor. To me, like it is with most of us, this show is synonymous with family. I have also come to realize that Dorothy is one of my heroes. She faced a hard and terrifying journey to self-confidence with bravery and heart. After playing her in 2012, I chose theatre as my career path. I moved states away from my family without knowing a single person and have found my own Kansas. The journey was sometimes hard and terrifying, but, like Dorothy, I faced it with bravery and heart. The Wizard of Oz summarizes what it takes to make a life for yourself. All you need is a brain, a lot of heart, and courage. With those, you'll find yourself a home. Then you fill it with family, chosen or not, and you'll have everything you'll need in this life. There really is no place like home.
